#### School Canteen

- We are a "Healthy Schools Canteen"
- There are 2 paid positions, Tracy the canteen manager and Cara the canteen assistant.

#### School Canteen

- To order lunch or recess go to Flexischools, the orders are then delivered to your child's class.
- Counter Service will hopefully be available again in 2022, this gives students the opportunity to come to the canteen counter with cash and purchase a drink or snack at both lunch and recess.

#### Breakfast Club

- We have a Breakfast Club Coordinator who runs BC.
- BC has not been operational during COVID, with restrictions easing in 2022, fingers crossed we will be back.
- Provides breakfast for any child who needs it to give them a healthy start to the day.
- Operated by volunteers we need 2-3 volunteers each morning for about ½ hour – you will need to serve cereal, toast and fruit to students.
