Class organisation for 2016

Students in Years 1- 6 in 2016 will start back at school on Thursday, 28 January 2016. On this day, students can come to school and place their bags at their 2015 classroom. There will be an assembly held in the morning and the students will not be placed in their 2016 year groups until our school numbers can be confirmed. The reason for this is because there are often a lot of changes to enrolments over the school holidays, eg students leaving and new ones arriving.

The school aims to have the students in their 2016 classes by the end of the first week of school.

Home Readers

Can all families start to return their home readers for the year please. They will now be sorted in readiness for 2016. If your child still has home readers at home, please send them into school as soon as possible.

Uniform Shop

The Uniform Shop will be open on Wednesday, 27 January 2016 (Staff Development Day) from 8.30 - 10.00 am and also on Thursday, 28 January 2016 and Friday, 29 January 2016 from 8.30 am - 10.00 am.

Invoicing

The 2016 school financial year began on Monday, 1 December 2015. All families have now been invoiced for the 2016 Voluntary General Contribution, P&C Levy and Supercover. Payments can be taken at the school office. Please note, payments for 2016 Kindergarten children cannot be made until Week 2, 2016.

Supercover

The school has once again decided to implement the "Supercover" system in 2016. Supercover will only be available to those families who have paid their voluntary school contribution at the beginning of the year (\$60.00).

What is Supercover?

"Supercover" is an optional fee that can be paid at the start of the year for each student. (Individual payment for the shows and excursions that Supercover includes is still possible as the events occur through the year should you choose not to take the Supercover option.)

The cost for 2016 is \$19.00 which can be paid in advance for the following shows and includes a discount per child:-Hunter Life Education Van; 1 x Visiting Show and the Military Museum Excursion.

The system is much easier for both parents and carers and for the administration staff because there will be less money coming in small amounts and less permission notes. Please note: Permission notes will still be sent home to all children. It will state on the permission note if the event is covered by Supercover. If you have paid Supercover, there will be no need to return the permission note.

When will Supercover need to be paid?

Supercover will need to be paid before Wednesday, 23 March 2016.

A permission note will need to be filled out to give your child permission to attend the relevant activities and will appear in the newsletter in 2016.

School Reports

Student reports will be sent home on Friday, 11 December. Please take the time to read and explain aspects of these reports to your child/ren. The teachers have spent many long hours assessing, evaluating and monitoring each student to eventually develop these reports.

School Supplies

In 2016, the school will be supplying all students with exercise books and some limited stationery needs. Parents and carers of students in Years 1-6 are asked to supply basic stationery requirements such as rulers, eraser, coloured pencils, lead pencils, pencil case, glue sticks, sharpeners, textas, pens (for older grades), etc and replace these items throughout the year. Parents will be advised of any other requirements when classes are formed in early 2016.

Sports Presentation - Friday, 11 December

The school will be holding a Sports Presentation Assembly on Friday, 11 December at 12.00 pm.

The assembly will include:-

- Awards to students for sports participation any student who has represented the school in PSSA knockout events, gala days, zone, hunter and state carnivals,
- The announcement of house captains for 2016, and
- Coaches Awards presented to students who have shown great sportsmanship and commitment to the team.

All are welcome to attend.

Kinder Party Day

For the Kindergarten end of year party day on Wednesday, 16 December, we have planned a walk to Townhead Park, Singleton. We will leave school at 9.30 am then have lunch and play on the bike tracks and equipment. We will walk back to school, leaving the park at 1.00 pm. Children will be accompanied by the Kindergarten teachers and two teacher's aide.

Upon arrival at Townhead Park, we will have a play on the equipment in the park then have our party lunch at approximately 12 noon. Children need to bring their own lunch and a small something to share plus 2 drinks as it can be very hot. Our bags will be taken by car to the park. Children can wear party clothes but must wear closed in shoes and a good hat (no caps). Children must wear sunscreen to start with and more will be available at the park.

Stage 1 Party Day

Stage 1 (Year 1&2) party day will be held on Thursday, 10 December students will be participating in water activities/ games at school. A note was sent home on Monday.

Year 5 Party Day

Year 5 Party Day will be held on Tuesday, 15 December. Students will be participating in water activities and pizza at school. The cost is \$4.00. A note was sent home last week.
