From the Principal

Class Structures

The start of the school year is always a balancing act with determining exactly the number of classes that actual enrolments will permit us to form. The Department of Education utilises a staffing formula based upon student numbers; until numbers are confirmed it is difficult to confirm the exact number and make up of classes. This is the reason why our school (and many other schools) did not go straight into new classes at the start of the year. With a finite number of classes and varying enrolment numbers across the year groups, the need to create combined stage classes (or composites) is an issue faced on a regular basis. At present, we have large numbers enrolled across the school especially in Years 2, 4 and 5.

Currently we have formed 16 mainstream classes. This will, in effect, alter our staffing allocation from the NSW DoE should we not have any new students enrol in the next few days. Our current class structure means teachers are operating at or above capacity with student numbers.

We are only a few students short of being able to form 17 classes, which would reduce the number of students in each Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 class. **With this in mind, our current classes will remain 'flexible' and may be restructured to form the extra class if new students enrol over the next couple of days/weeks.** To maximise and utilise our available resources and staffing allocations composite/stage classes may be developed.

The executive will work closely with teachers to make changes that will have the least amount of movement for classes and students.

Having your child in a stage/composite class does not reflect negatively or more favourably upon an individual child. A range of characteristics, academic abilities, and personalities exist in every class. Our highly professional teachers work to meet the needs of each child to foster growth and development. Teachers often need to cater for differences in learning around 18 to 24 months in the same room, even when the class is a single grade.

Parent 'Meet and Greet' Afternoon

Teachers will be conducting a 'Meet and Greet' afternoon on Tuesday, 18 February. Session information will also be available in a handout and will be sent home with students the following day for those parents unable to attend. Sessions will commence at 5.00 pm - 5:30 pm with a repeat sessions from 5:30 - 6.00 pm. 'Meet and Greet' locations will be updated in the coming week on a 'Meet and Greet' flyer as well as the School App and Facebook page.

New Signage

Over the holiday period, the installation of new school signage and PBL signs commenced. Our Hunter St entrance and I Block Building now clearly identify our school, the entrance and SPS expectations.

Two Acknowledgment of Country signs have also been installed – one in the Enter to Learn entrance and another on the pathway from the office building. These are a fabulous addition as part of our Aboriginal Education Team initiatives, recognising and respecting culture within our school and community.

Our school Mascot chosen by the students of SPS now features on our signage and will be introduced into many other aspects of our student behaviour and wellbeing directions throughout 2020.

- Don't forget to add an **ice brick** to keep the food cool and safe

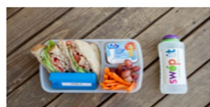

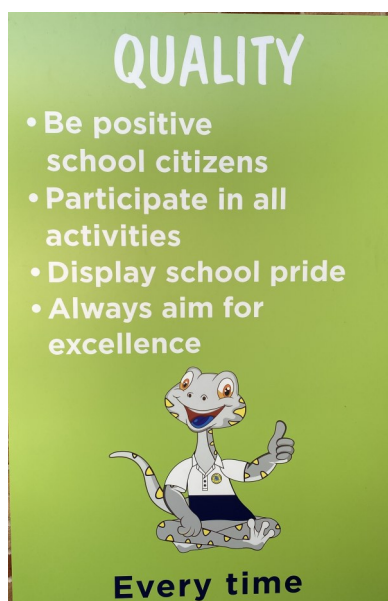
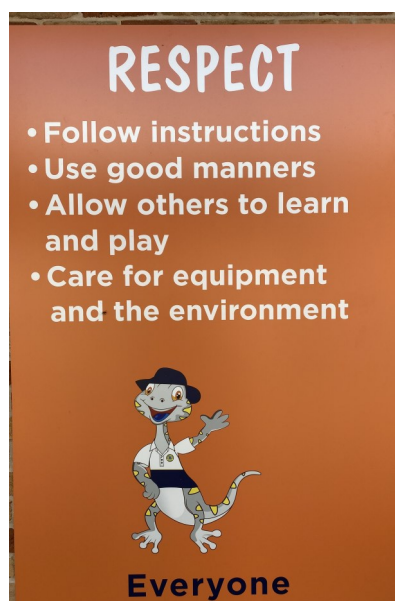

New Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) Signage

SPS PBL Core Expectations of Respect, Responsibility and Quality are now clearly visible as you enter our school (on the end of I Block). PBL signs are also located in designated locations around the school as points of reference for students, teachers and visitors of our behaviour expectations for each area.



Hours of Supervision

Please be aware that the school does not provide supervision prior to 8.40 am. Children should not arrive at school before this time as no teachers will be on duty. **Children are dismissed promptly at 3.10 pm.** Arrangements should be made for all children to be collected as soon as possible after they are dismissed. Please write a short note to your child's teacher if you have arranged alternate travel or collection plans to assist us in caring for your child. The gates on Hunter Street can be closed as early as 3.30 pm depending on staff commitments and the gates on Elizabeth Street are closed after the last bus leaves the school. Please ensure travel arrangements are confirmed with your child at the start of the day.

Administration Matters

Receipting of Money

For security reasons the school office does not receipt any money after **12.30 pm** each day. As our banking is done at that time, this ensures that no large amounts of cash are held on the premises after hours. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.

Personal Information

It is vitally important that the school has current contact details for all of our students. Please contact the Office if you have changed phone numbers, employment or address in the past few months and ensure that your details are correct. It is also important to remember to keep emergency contact details up to date as well.

Waiting Areas after School

Please be mindful that school finishes at 3.10 pm. It is important for your child that you wait in the playground areas and not outside the classrooms as it becomes a distraction during your child's learning time.

However, if you would like to help out as a volunteer within the classroom, please see your class teacher at a suitable time. Thanks for your assistance in providing a high quality education for your child.

Nut Allergies

A reminder that there are children in our school who have life threatening allergies to nuts. This includes all nut products including peanut butter and Nutella. Even a trace of peanut butter on another child's breath or coming in touch with some residual peanut butter from eating lunch can be fatal for children who are anaphylactic. Please support these children by not sending your child to school with any nut products.

Medical Information Forms

Each year the school sends home Medical Information Forms for completion by parents and / or caregivers for use on any activities held outside the school grounds. These forms have been sent home this week and need to be returned to class teachers by Monday, 17 February 2020. Students that do not have a signed medical note returned to the school will not be able to participate in any school activities that are held outside the school premises. Spare copies are available at the school office or on the school's website under "Permission and Other Notes".

General Permission Notes

General permission notes have been sent home to every student for completion and return to their class teacher by Monday, 17 February 2020. This note covers any walking activities, excursions, sports events that occur throughout the year that have been approved by the principal. Notices will appear in the newsletter when an event is coming up that is covered by the permission note.

Supercover

The school has once again decided to implement the "Supercover" system in 2020. Supercover will only be available to those families who have paid their voluntary school contribution at the beginning of the year (\$60.00).

What is Supercover?

"Supercover" is an optional fee that can be paid at the start of each year which covers two shows at a discounted rate.

The cost for 2020 is \$11.00 which can be paid in advance for the following shows per child:-

1 x Visiting Show (Brainstorm Production on 4, March) ;

1 x Visiting Show (Musica Viva in Term 2)

The system is much easier for both parents and carers and for the administration staff because there will be less money coming in small amounts and less permission notes. Please note: Permission notes will still be sent home to all children. It will state on the permission note if the event is covered by Supercover. If you have paid Supercover, there will be no need to return the permission note. There are no refunds available under the Supercover scheme. Shows and excursions can be paid separately if you do not choose to pay Supercover.

When will Supercover need to be paid?

Supercover will need to be paid before Friday, 28 February 2020. The two Supercover shows will be included on your family's Statement of Account until this date. After 28 February, the prices will be increased to the non-discounted price.

The permission note will need to be completed to give your child permission to attend the visiting shows.

Benefits of "Kiss and Go"

There are a number of benefits from adopting a "Kiss and Go" approach to dropping your child at school. These include:

- the building of independence skills for the child as they will quickly learn the morning routines and expectations;
- increased free play and social building opportunities – without Mum or Dad in the playground children quickly find a friend to interact and play with. It is amazing how much energy young children can burn in five minutes;
- reduced anxiety and stress for other students – often it is not your child crying in morning lines, it is another child who is 'missing' their parent. The presence of additional parents in the school grounds can increase this anxiety;
- improved traffic flow around the school and increased pedestrian safety – we all know how hectic and difficult it can be to get a park around school grounds in the morning;
- increased opportunities for your child to interact with teachers and staff at the school in a relaxed, informal setting.

Zone Swimming Carnival

The Zone Swimming Carnival will be held on Tuesday, 18 February at the Scone Memorial Swimming Pool. The carnival will commence at 9.00 am but competitors will need to be at the pool by 8.30 am. Please meet Mrs O'Brien and Mrs Black inside the pool. The cost will be advised on the note and it will need to be paid to the school office by Monday, 17 February. Pool entry is to be paid on the day of the carnival (this will also be advised on the upcoming note). Students that qualified for zone swimming will receive a note home in the coming weeks. Students are to make their own way to the pool and bring food, water, sunscreen, swimmers and towel. Please wear swimmers under school uniform. Good luck to all swimmers.

Parent Online Payment (POP)

Our Parent Online Payment system is available for your easy access to paying your school voluntary contributions, P&C Levy, excursions, etc. A tab appears on the school website under "Our School" called "Parent Online Payment" - <http://www.singleton-p.schools.nsw.edu.au/our-school/parent-online-payment>.

This tab explains the use of the new Parent Online Payment system including some instructions and a payment advice.

Please remember that some payments cannot be done through the system such as first in best dressed excursions, payments for the school group photos for MSP Photography in Term 2, payments for the P&C movie ticket fundraiser.

Please note: the parent online payments work most successfully on a computer. They do not always work on phones or tablets.

Scripture and Non Scripture Arrangements 2020

Scripture at Singleton Public School will be the same format as last year. It will consist of an assembly type format.

Scripture will begin at Singleton PS in Week 3. Year K-2 scripture will run from 2.05 pm until 2.35 pm in the hall. Year 3-6 will run from 2.35 pm until 3.05 pm in the hall.

All children will attend scripture except for those students who have the following religions listed on their enrolment forms: cc denominational, Islam, Jehovah's Witness, Buddhism, Spiritualism, Judaism and Baha'i. If parents/carers do not wish their child/ren to attend scripture, a note needs to be handed in at the school office listing your child's name, their class and reason for exemption. Please note: This no longer needs to be done every year, a record has been kept of the students that did not attend scripture in 2019.

The children who will not be attending scripture now will be participating in programs that include social skills. The K-2 students will be part of the APEEL program whilst Year 3-6 will be undertaking the age appropriate social skills lessons. These sessions will be conducted by members of our staff.

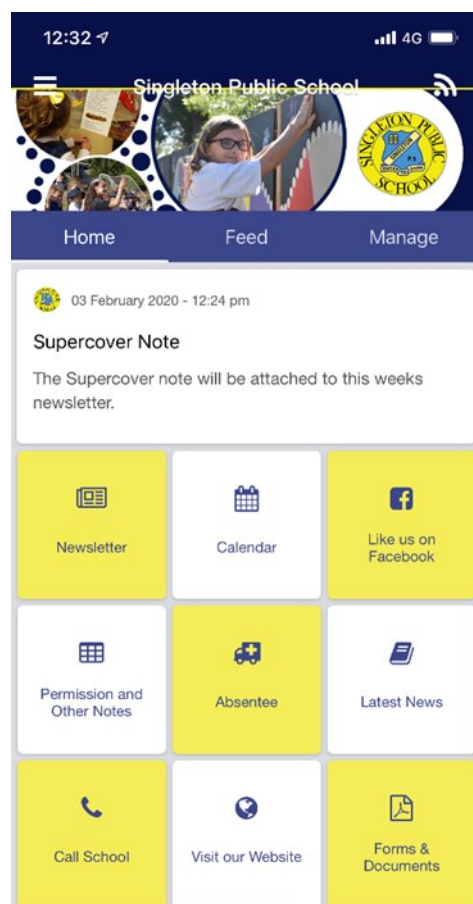
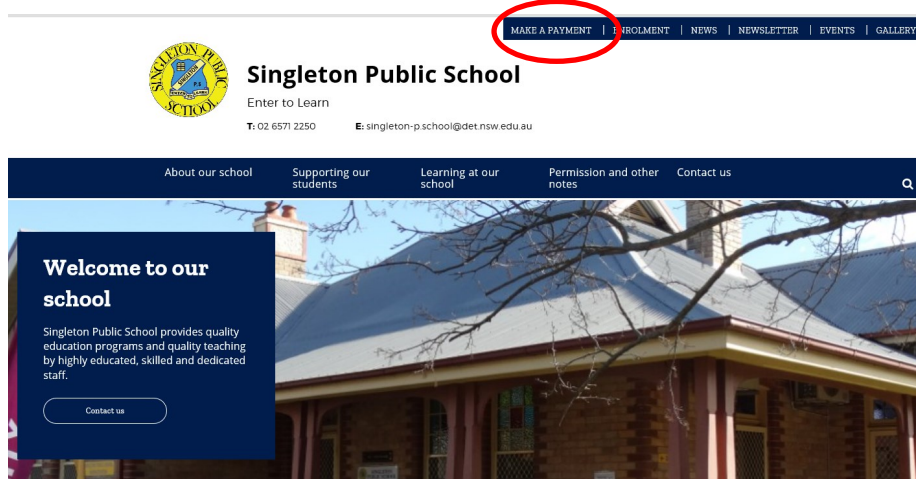
School App

The school currently uses an app called Schoolzine to communicate with our school community. It has features such as the ability for the school to send out notifications for school excursions, sport days and other information, links to our website's newsletters, calendar of events and permission notes, absentee notifications, etc.

It is a very easy app to use and download.

Simply go to the App Store and search, download and install SZapp. Select the region as Asia Pacific and search for Singleton Public School. Register as a user with an email, google or Facebook. Manage notifications by allowing all of the push notifications.

The app as it is an important part of our communication with our parents and carers. Announcements, regular updates and reminders are frequently made through our school app, so please ensure you download the app to receive notifications and avoid missing any updates.

What is Supercover?

"Supercover" is an optional fee that can be paid at the start of each year which covers two shows at a discounted rate.


