Singleton Public School

As per Department of Education (DoE) requirements, parents/carers must return signed enrolment forms along with supporting enrolment documents including their child's birth certificate, immunisation statement and 100 points proof of address documents for their child to be eligible to attend both Bluey's 'Small Steps, Big Futures' Transition to School Program and Kindergarten Orientation days.

These programs are not an education or care service, but are run for the purpose of orienting children to the school. Parents/carers must be readily available and easily contactable during these sessions.

Kindergarten Orientation

On the following days, children are invited to attend Kindergarten Orientation sessions. The Kindergarten Orientation sessions are very important for children to become familiar with school routines, the school setting and the Kindergarten classrooms. They are a chance for the children to get to know the teachers, the classrooms and more importantly, an opportunity to meet their new classmates. Each session will be structured and organised to enable children to experience a variety of activities and lessons in preparation for Kindergarten learning. While the students are at the Kinder Orientation, parents/carers are invited to stay for the second parent information session on 30 October and a Literacy and Numeracy information session on 6 November. Parents/carers and 2026 kindergarten students are invited to join our Singleton Public School team for a picnic and get to know you session with rotating activities for the 13 November session. The children will need to attend the three sessions listed below:-

Bluey's 'Small Steps, Big Futures' Transition to School Program

The Bluey's 'Small Steps, Big Futures' transition to school program will run on Fridays for 4 weeks in Term 3 on **Fridays 29 August and 5, 12, 19 September 2025 (Term 3, Weeks 6-9)**.

The session will run from 9.30 am – 11.00 am.

The program will orientate the incoming Kindergarten children with an opportunity to mix socially with their peers and become familiar with the school environment.

Children will be required to bring a labelled hat and a drink bottle.

Children will meet our Kindergarten staff under the tree in front of the office for the sessions.
