Year 3 Intensive Swimming Program 2022

10 June 2022

All students in Year 3 will be attending an Intensive Learn-to-Swim campaign in Term 3, 2022. This will occur every school day over two weeks. This intensive program is a NSW Department of Education initiative; therefore, it is a recommended program for all Year 2 students. **However, due to COVID19 restrictions in 2021, our Year 3 students were unable to attend. They are being offered the program in 2022 instead.**

Students will be tested and put into groups according to their ability. Stronger swimmers will receive squad coaching while others may receive coaching on breathing and stroke technique, as well as activities to develop strength and stamina in the water. **Therefore it is expected that ALL students participate in the program.** Please note: Day 9 will be the assessing day and Day 10 will be Safety Day.

Dates: Wednesday, 25 July to Friday, 5 August 2022 (Weeks 2 and 3 of Term 3)

Cost: \$85.00 (lessons and bus for two weeks)

Payment due: Wednesday, 20 July, 12.30 pm

Equipment: Swimmers, towel and goggles (clearly labelled) and for Safety Day (Day 10) long pants and a long sleeved shirt are required.

Please note: Refunds will not be possible from Wednesday, 20 July 2022 as the Centre has organised the professional swimming teachers and they have a no refund policy. **Memberships/season tickets at the Gym & Swim Centre are not valid for learn to swim programs.**

We welcome any parents/carers who would like to assist with the program. You do not have to instruct only assist professional instructors.

The session time for the two weeks is Session 1 Year 3 12.30 – 1.15 pm.

The Gym and Swim requires any volunteers to have a current Working with Children Check while the school requires a completed Declaration for Child-Related Workers form. If you do not have a check, you are able to apply for one online and then have it completed at Service NSW. Simply go to <https://www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/child-safe-organisations/working-with-children-check>, complete the online application form, selecting the purpose of check category "Volunteer". You will then be issued with an application number. Take this number and paperwork to the Service NSW with your 100 point check documents eg Birth Certificate (70 points) and Driver's Licence (40 points). Once a Working with Children Check number is issued (it may take a few days) please bring a copy into the school. If you have any queries about this see the office staff. Please sign below if you are able to help.

If you need assistance financing this program please contact Mrs Kerrie Burns in the school office. All requests are strictly confidential and must be made at least two weeks prior to the commencement of the program. Strictly no late payments can be accepted.
